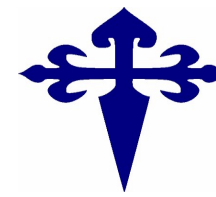

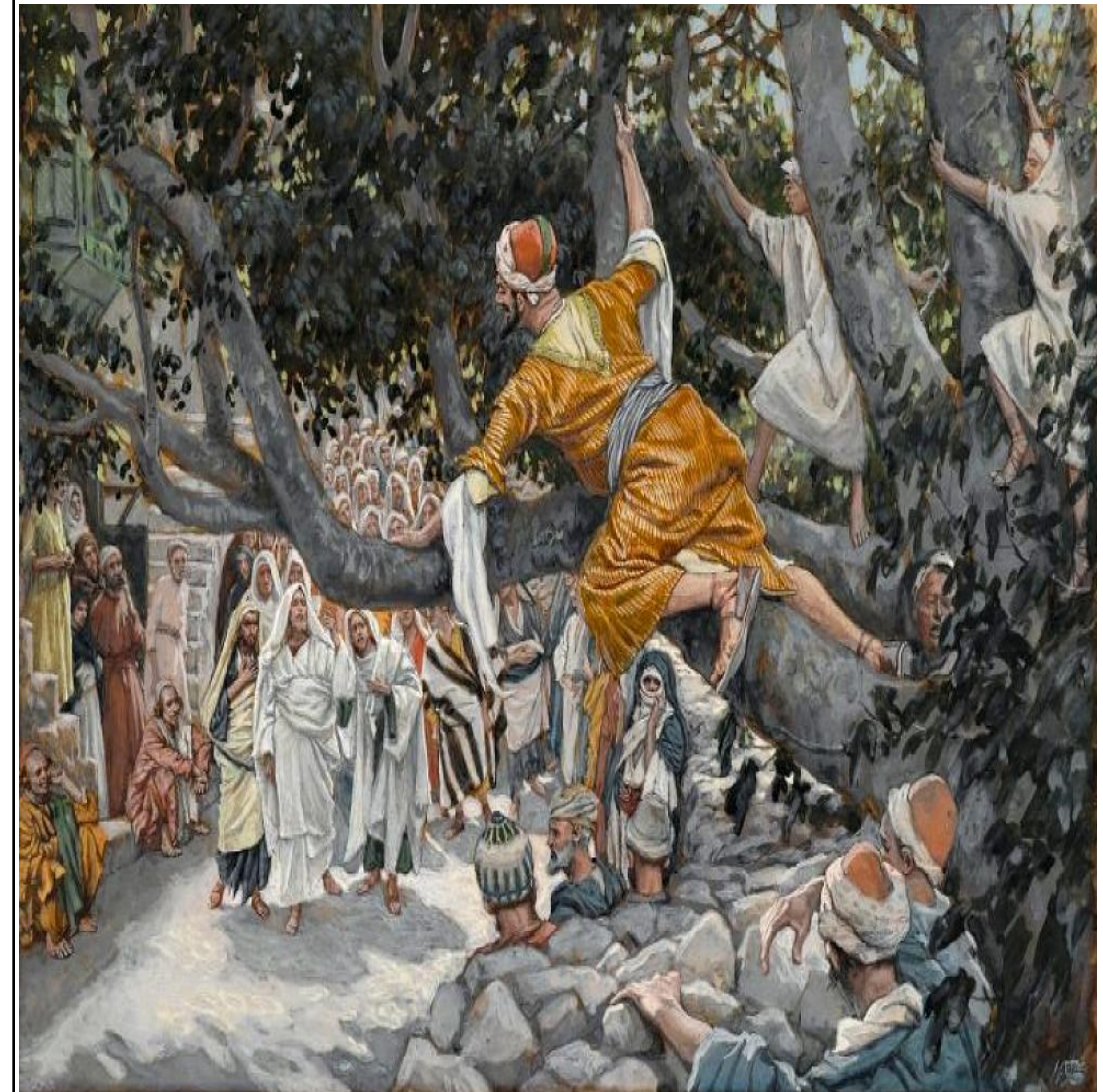

REFLECTION FOR ADVENT AT

ST. GREGORY'S ABBEY:

Advent is the season encompassing the four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up to the celebration of Christmas. In the season of Advent, we await the coming of Christ on all the levels in which we experience time: in the past -as a babe in the stable of Bethlehem; in the present-as grace in our souls; and in the future-as the Judge at the end of time. This day of reflection on **November 12**, will focus on these three actions of Christ's coming into our world and into our hearts and how we might use this time of preparation to deepen our awareness of them.
