GOSPEL Mark 6:7-13

Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two and gave them authority over unclean spirits. He instructed them to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick-no food, no sack, no money in their belts. They were, however, to wear sandals but not a second tunic. He said to them, "Wherever you enter a house, stay there until you leave. Whatever place does not welcome you or listen to you, leave there and shake the dust off your feet in testimony against them." So they went off and preached repentance. The Twelve drove out many demons, and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them.

STRATEGIC PLANNING UPDATE

- 1. Over the past few months, we have been engaged in Strategic Planning for the future of both St. James and St. John Parishes. I realize this has been a challenging process for all of us as we look to where the Holy Spirit is calling us into the future.
- 2. I wish to state that no decisions have been made regarding the closing, moving, or changing current Mass times of either parish.
- 3. I wish to apologize for any pain this process has caused members of our community as we have labored in this question. Change is difficult for all of us. Information that is not reflective of the process and the discussions that are happening has floated through the community creating tension and division. This pains me as your pastor, and I want nothing more than to bring unity to our community.
- 4. We have also surfaced that over the history of both parishes trust has been broken by pastors, by the Diocese, and between parishioners. I recognize that it is hard to look to the future and ask people to flex and change if trust isn't there.
- 5. I and the Team desire to understand where trust and credibility has broken down over the years so that I and the planning team can work to rebuild trust and credibility as we look to the future full of hope.
- 6. On August 11, 12 and 13 we will host a series of listening sessions for you to come and engage in conversation where your story can be heard. These are going to be honorable conversations that allow myself, the Team, and Fr. Kastl, the Vicar General, to hear your heart, your pain, your hopes and anxieties about the future. More information will come out regarding how to sign up and participate. We are reviewing other avenues of communication for those unavailable on these dates or who don't feel comfortable in an open setting as proposed.
- 7. Let me reiterate no decisions have been made to close St. James or St. John. Help me and help us know the deeper realities of our communities.



BLESSED STANLEY
ROTHER, PRIEST AND
MARTYR

Blessed Stanley Francis Rother was born in Okarche, Oklahoma, USA on 27 March 1935. He discerned a call to the priesthood and began seminary formation in 1953. After initial academic struggles, he completed his

seminary studies and was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Oklahoma City and Tulsa on 25 May 1963. After five years of parish ministry he volunteered for the Oklahoma Catholic mission in Guatemala and spent the remainder of his life ministering there. He served his people generously even mastering their difficult language so that he could provide pastoral care and form them in their faith. When a bloody civil war reached his remote mission he chose to remain among his parishioners in spite of the danger to himself. Unknown assailants broke into the rectory at Santiago Atitlán and murdered Father Rother during the night of 28 July 1981. He was beatified in Oklahoma City on 23 September 2017.
