

GOSPEL: John 6:41-51

The Jews murmured about Jesus because he said, "I am the bread that came down from heaven," and they said, "Is this not Jesus, the son of Joseph? Do we not know his father and mother? Then how can he say, 'I have come down from heaven'?" Jesus answered and said to them, "Stop murmuring among yourselves. No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draw him, and I will raise him on the last day. It is written in the prophets: They shall all be taught by God. Isdory was ordained a priest for Catholic Archdiocese of Tabora in Tanzania on Sept. 25, 2014. Currently he is taking a summer break from finishing up his Masters studies in Canon Law in Rome where he was awarded a Master's Degree in May.

Our Mission is to preach the Good News to all people, to enhance evangelization through a participatory approach. To empower the Tabora community by involving the faithful in the identification of issues and helping them solve their own social problems. To make this mission possible we focus on widespread evangelization, furthering social-economic development, provision of health services for all, notably HIV/AIDS Victims, education of orphans/vulnerable children, building small Christian Communities and supporting the poor and the marginalized.
