

GOSPEL: Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

When the Pharisees with some scribes who had come from Jerusalem gathered around Jesus, they observed that some of his disciples ate their meals with unclean, that is, unwashed hands. - For the Pharisees and, in fact, all Jews, do not eat without carefully washing their hands, keeping the tradition of the elders. And on coming from the marketplace they do not eat without purifying themselves. And for there are many other things that they have traditionally observed, the purification of cups and jugs and kettles and beds. - So the Pharisees and scribes questioned him, "Why do your disciples not follow the tradition of the elders but instead eat a meal with unclean hands?" He responded, "Well did Isaiah prophesy about you hypocrites, as it is written: *This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me; in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines human precepts.* You disregard God's commandment but cling to human tradition." He summoned the crowd again and said to them, "Hear me, all of you, and understand. Nothing that enters on from outside can defile that person; but the things that come out from within are what defile.

"From within people, from their hearts, come evil thoughts, unchastity, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, licentiousness, envy, blasphemy, arrogance, folly. All these evils come from within and they defile."

THE CATHOLIC SPIRITUAL BOOK CLUB

begins **Wednesday**, **September 18** with Part 1 &2 of "Thea's Song" - The Life of Thea Bowman." This is the contemporary story of a woman who happened to be a descendant of slaves, who was born in 1937 as a Protestant, became Catholic at nine, and joined the Franciscan Sisters in 1953.

The book was suggested in the spring of 2024 as a modern story of a woman who followed God's call. Sister Thea used God's gifts to work for her Catholic faith with the motto "Let me live until I die!" She used her life to teach elementary school, earn a master of arts degree and a PhD from Catholic University. In 1978 while in Mississippi to care for her aging parents, the Bishop asked her to develop an outreach program for Intercultural awareness.

Using God's gift of her faith life, she introduced both a speaking and singing ministry that reached across the nation. Sister Thea lived from 1937 to 1990, is remembered as someone whose story is perfect for "the weary souls who want to keep alive the dreamthe dream of faith, caring and connection for all the contemporary Catholic Church."
