Gospel: Luke 1:1-4, 4:14-21

Since many have undertaken to compile a narrative of the events that have been fulfilled among us, just as those who were eye-witnesses from the beginning and ministers of the word have handed them down to us, I too have decided, after investigating everything accurately anew, to write it down in an orderly sequence for you, most excellent Theophilus, so that you may realize the certainty of the teachings you have received.

Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news of him spread throughout the whole region. He taught in their synagogues and was praised by all.

He came to Nazareth, where he a grown up, and went according to his custom into the synagogue on the sabbath day. He stood up to read and was handed a scroll of the prophet Isaiah. He unrolled the scroll and found the passage where it was written: *The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord.* Rolling up the scroll, he handed it back to the attendant and sat down, and the eyes of all in the synagogue looked intently at him. He said to them, "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing."

**"Sacrament of Healing: Anointing of the Sick"
Session 20 with Fr. Carvajal
Tuesday, January 28, 6:30pm at St. James**

In common with all the sacraments, Anointing of the Sick confers sanctifying grace. The primary purpose of the special grace of this sacrament is to comfort and strengthen the soul of the sick person; it quiets anxiety and dissipates fear. It enables the sick person to embrace God's will and to face the possibility of death without apprehension and gives the soul strength to face and conquer whatever temptations to doubt, despondency, or despair may mark Satan's last effort to seize this soul for himself. In receiving this sacrament in our last illness, it prepares the soul for entrance into heaven by the forgiveness of venial sins and the cleansing of the soul from the remains of sin. **Come and See!**
