







RCIA Session #15 The Sacrament of Baptism Presenter: Fr. Carlos

RCIA begins the New Year by taking a look at the seven Sacraments of the Catholic Church; the primary means by which God spiritually feeds, heals, and strength-

ens us. Baptism is the foundational sacrament upon which all the other are grounded. It disposes, prepares, and enables the soul to receive the other sacraments. Without baptism, it would be impossible to validly receive the others. Join Fr.
